The support of club leaders, callers, cuers and dancers allows TAWS to continue to provide information to members regarding square and round dance events across Australia. Our website (<u>www.taws.info</u>) and Android app (TAWS) is accurately and promptly maintained by Carl Mullan and Karen McCarthy. I thank them on your behalf for their efforts.

Distribution of emails has been much easier since I have been using Mailchimp. I have 297 email addresses on my data base and statistics show that between 40% and 60% of recipients open their emails.
